Monday, November 9 (L)

Today, via deluxe Lamers coach, we'll travel south and east, heading to the **Louisville, Kentucky area**. En route we will witness autumn in Wisconsin, Illinois, and Indiana. We'll make bathroom stops and an **included lunch** stop along the way, but our focus will be our destination. Late afternoon we'll check into our hotel. Night in **Scottsburg, IN**.

Tuesday, November 10 (B, L,) Nashville

This morning after our **included breakfast**, we will continue moving south on I-65 to Nashville, Tennessee. Our **included lunch** will be at the famous **Wildhorse Saloon** in the heart of historic downtown Nashville. This three-story historic warehouse is now the hub of THE Nashville experience. We will also enjoy some line dance lessons to get us in the country music mood. Check in to our downtown hotel will be in the late afternoon. We will be staying at the brand new Drury Plaza Hotel just a few blocks off Broadway where all the action takes place. You will have time to check in and enjoy Drury's Kickback which includes drinks and hot foods. Then it is off to the world famous **Ryman Auditorium** for a fun-filled country music show. Ryman Auditorium was the home of the Grand Ole Opry from 1943-1974. This 2,364 seat auditorium is on the National Register of Historic Places and is a National Historic Landmark. After the show it is back to the hotel or, if you wish, spend some time downtown. Night in **Nashville**.

Wednesday, November 11 (B, L) Nashville

This morning after our **included breakfast**, we will enjoy a **guided tour of Nashville**. Following the tour we will board the **General Jackson Showboat**. While cruising, take time to experience the Nashville skyline as it can best be seen from the beautiful Cumberland River. An **included lunch and a live "Taste of Tennessee" show** will round out our afternoon. After docking we will head across the parking lot to the Gaylord Opryland Resort. This hotel has an amazing Christmas light display amongst its nine acres of lush indoor gardens. Take time to admire the sights and find dinner at one of the many restaurants in the resort. Later, **we will enjoy an included show at the resort**. After the show, it is back to our hotel. Night in **Nashville**.

Thursday, November 12 (B, L) Nashville

We'll begin our day with an **included breakfast** at our hotel and then set out to visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Studio B**. The museum houses one of the world's largest music collections. The displays and memories will keep you intrigued during the entire time of your visit. We will then have an **included lunch at the Loveless Café**. The café is famous for their Southern cooking and scratch-made biscuits. We will be back to our hotel early afternoon so you can enjoy downtown Nashville on your own. Your options are nearly endless. Only a few blocks from our hotel you can find Broadway which has many honky tonks, restaurants, and gift shops. Also within a few blocks of the hotel is the Johnny Cash Museum and Café, Goo Goo Cluster Shop, Patsy Cline Museum, Blake Shelton's Ole Red, Music City Center, Bridgestone Arena, breweries, and so much more. Night in **Nashville**.

Friday, November 13 (B, D) Indianapolis

Our day begins again with an **included breakfast**. Then it is time to start heading north. After a drive of a few hours, it will be time to find lunch on your own. A tour of downtown Indianapolis, including the many monuments in this beautiful city, will fill out our afternoon. Then we will settle in at our hotel. The final night of our tour will **include dinner** and the musical **"The Phantom of the Opera"** at the **Beef and Boards Dinner Theater**. Night in **Indianapolis**.

Saturday, November 14 (B)

After an **included breakfast**, we will continue to work our way north. The miles will seem to fly by with the memories of a week of southern entertainment. We will stop for lunch on your own and be back in Wisconsin in the late afternoon.
