### **Monday, April 25 (L)**

Today, via deluxe Lamers coach, we'll begin traveling south. En route we will witness springtime in Wisconsin and Illinois. We'll make bathroom stops and an **included lunch** stop along the way. Then our focus will be our destination, the Drury Inn in Marion, IL. The Drury offers a Kickback with drinks and heavy appetizers in the evening. This may just enough for your dinner this evening or you may venture out to a nearby restaurant. Night in **Marion, IL**.

### **Tuesday, April 26 (B, L,) Nashville-Downtown**

This morning after our **included breakfast**, we will continue moving south and east to Nashville, Tennessee. By midday we will arrive at the beautiful **Belle Meade Plantation**. We will learn the history of the Greek-revival style mansion and its 30 acres of buildings dating back to the 1840's. This historic site will be our stop for **lunch**, followed by a tour of the grounds and wine tasting. Then it is off to our beautiful hotel in downtown Nashville. The evening is yours to explore the honky-tonks and the great entertainment on **Broadway** just a few blocks away. Night in downtown **Nashville**.

### **Wednesday, April 27 (B, L, D) Nashville-Opryland**

This morning after our **included breakfast**, we will enjoy a **guided tour of Nashville**. A few of the many Nashville highlights are the Tennessee state capitol, Parthenon, Centennial Park, and the homes of some of the stars. We may even hear a few tunes during our guided tour! Then it will be show time as we board the **General Jackson Showboat** in "Music City". We will begin with an **included buffet lunch**, followed by the energetic show starring some of Nashville's finest musicians and singers. While cruising, there may be time to view the Nashville skyline as it can best be seen from the beautiful Cumberland River. After docking we will head over to the **Grand Ole Opry** for a tour to see what happens behind the scenes in the place that made country music famous. It will be time to check in to our hotel near Opryland. After a bit of time to relax and freshen up, we will head out to enjoy the **"Sound of Nashville" dinner and show**. Night in **Nashville**.

## Thursday, April 28 (B, L, D) Nashville-Opryland

We'll begin our day with an **included breakfast** at our hotel and then set out to visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame and Studio B**. The museum houses one of the world's largest music collections. The displays and memories will keep you intrigued during the entire time of your visit. Our **included lunch** will be at the famous **Wildhorse Saloon** in the heart of historic downtown Nashville. This three-story historic warehouse is now the hub of THE Nashville experience. We will also enjoy some line dance lessons to get us in the country music mood. After lunch it is over to the famous **Ryman Auditorium** - home of the Grand Ole Opry for 30+ years. Stand in the uniquely decorated dressing rooms and on the stage where country stars of yesterday and today still stand. Next, we will take a little break before we celebrate the classics and latest hits of country music at the **Nashville Night Life Dinner Theater**. Night in **Nashville**.

## Friday, April 29 (B, L) Indianapolis

Our day begins again with an **included breakfast**. Then it is time to start traveling north. After a drive of a few hours, we will be in the middle of Kentucky thoroughbred horse country. We will enjoy a catered lunch at **Windy Meadows Horse Farm** followed by a tour of the farm. Time will be allowed in the quaint and beautiful town of LaGrange for a little shopping or a treat. A few hours' drive up the road will be our stop for the night in Indianapolis. Dinner is on your own tonight. Night in **Indianapolis**.

## Saturday, April 30 (B,L)

After an **included breakfast**, we continue to work our way north. We will make one more interesting stop followed by an **included lunch**. As we continue toward Wisconsin, the miles will seem to fly by with the memories of a toe tappin' week of southern entertainment. We will be back in Wisconsin in the late afternoon. Drop-off locations will be the same as pick-up locations.
